Lesson Title	Plant Parts	Code	SG3-009	Grade	G3
Objective	Students will identify the parts of a plant and their main functions.				
Page 1	Title page.				
Page 2	Find out how much students already know about the parts of a plant by asking student volunteers to label this plant using the draggable icons. Drag from left to check answers.				
Page 3-9	Ask student volunteers to click on a plant part, and then click the Play button to run a short animation describing the main function of the part. Click BACK to return to the animation menu on Page 3. When you have reviewed all six plant parts, click CONTINUE to advance to page 10.				
Page 10	Ask student volunteers to click on an audio icon, and to then drag the appropriate plant part to the box provided. Drag from left to check answers.				
Page 11	Explain to students that the fruit and vegetables that we eat are actually plant parts. Ask student volunteers to use the Pen Tool to identify each of the plant parts as either: flower, leaf, fruit, seed, stem, or root. Due to space limitations, you may wish to suggest an abbreviation for each plant part. Click the Answer icon to check answers.				
Page 12	Answers to Page 11.				
Page 13	Ask student volunteers to click on an audio icon, and to then drag the appropriate plant part to the box provided. Drag from right to check answers.
